At the age of 2, Blake showed an interest in singing and by the age of 4, he began singing in church with his family. By the age of 6, Blake was signed to his first record contract and began traveling all over the USA performing and singing with his family.

For the last 21 years, Blake has worked professionally in every genre of music imaginable. He is currently the Front Man of 6 different bands including: The Mojo Brothers Blues Band, Saddletramp, The Stardusters Jazz Quartet, The Big Throwback, Chillbilly and Santa and The Sleigh Boys.

Blake has had the pleasure to perform alongside some of the most talented performers in the world, including most recently: Maurice Williams (The Zodiacs), Nicky Sanders (The Steep Canyon Rangers), Mike Barnes (The Black Crows, Grace Potter, Steve Miller), The Association, The Tams, Jeff Sipe (Jimmy Herring, Aquarium Rescue Unit, Warren Haynes, Derek Trucks) and Artimus Pyle (Lynyrd Skynyrd).

In addition to all of his experience in CCM styles (Contemporary Commercial Music), Blake is trained in Classical Voice Performance, holds a Bachelors Degree in Operatic Voice Performance, a Masters Level Education in Opera performance and was ranked as one of the Top 4 Operatic Tenors in the United States in 2014 (in his respective category) at NATS Competition in Boston, MA.

Most recently, Blake has been named "Outlaw Country Artist of the Year" at The Grand Ole Opry, has been named NACMAI's Traditional Gospel Entertainer of the Year, Traditional Gospel Vocalist of the Year, Traditional Gospel Instrumentalist of the Year in addition to becoming a Grammy Member and an American Idol Golden Ticket Winner!
